We would like to invite you to join us

on a service trip to the small African country of Eswatini (recently changed from Swaziland). As many of you know, we have been to Eswatini about 30 times, alone and guiding groups of up to 29 people. Let me tell you about this one and offer some snapshots of what could lie ahead for you.

The trip will be a total of **13 days** days on the ground, plus travel. There will be a maximum of 10 spots available, this trip will be women only. Think mother-daughter, teens over 15 years are welcome, partners, sisters, aunts, best friends.. Due to safari bookings, these dates are firm.



There will be days of work at the Moya Centre Preschool

The work will be of a nature that everyone can participate. We will be painting the interior and exterior of the new preschool. The exterior will be in a funky and fun mosaic, see the pic of a previous similar project above. We will be installing a playground structure, beginning a


garden, furnishing and perhaps adding fencing, all while you are there. The work can be adjusted to individual strengths, talents, abilities and interests. We can work with unskilled but keen, and we have even accommodate people who can't work at all.

You will also be asked to bring items in your baggage allowance for the preschool. Details to follow, but in particular warmer clothing for small boys ages 3-7 years, metal die cast toys, art supplies, Duplos etc.

One fun aspect to this particular service project, is that it is walking distance from your accommodations. It is very safe and you will enjoy walking with local people for the 1 km to the work site.

There will be days of viewing.

You can't come to Eswatini without seeing it. There will be at least one day where we tour the rural areas, view other projects with women and enjoy Eswatini's mountainous beauty.

Accommodations:

I have travelled this country from end to end and this is far and away the best accommodation in Eswatini. You will be staying at Malandelas's Lifestyle Center, BNB. Rooms are single, double or triple, each is unique, funky, fun, private, safe and very comfortable. All have private en-suites. There is a shared pool and nice spots for a sundowner. Some rooms have small decks. The main restaurant we eat at is about 50 meters away. There is a night watchman on at night. These grounds are spectacular with a mountains and sugar cane fields in the distance and very mature indigenous gardens all around, often used for weddings and gatherings. There is a live theatre onsite, called House on Fire, as well as little shops with fun local wares, and a British style pub. Internet connectivity is generally good.

After your service work and seeing Eswatini:

We will transition to a hiking lodge within Eswatini for 2 nights, accommodationshere are again very comfortable with private en-suites. Hiking will be optional. However, the scenery in the area IS stunning, but if hiking is not your thing, these will be wandering and reading days, as you prefer.

HOW MUCH DOES THIS TRIP COST? 2024 pricing is \$5,950 CAD per person. NOTE: GST and PST do NOT apply to these trips. This does not include airfare. (As a point of reference, the retail value of this safari at Inyati is \$2,800 per person.)

ACCEPTED FORMS OF PAYMENT

SINGLE OR DOUBLE OCCUPANCY? All pricing above is based on double occupancy. Single supplement while in Eswatini, add \$500 CAD to this price (available on first come first served basis, limited availability.) For single supplement on safari, add \$1,200 CAD (availability limited.)

WHAT IS INCLUDED IN THIS PACKAGE? All ground transfers to/from Johannesburg international airport to Eswatini and return, 3 day all-inclusive safari at Inyati Game Lodge in a private game reserve, Sabi Sands (Kruger National Park) all accommodations, all breakfasts, most lunches, all ground transportation while in Eswatini, 2 nights and hiking in the Phophonyane Eco Lodge area in the north of Eswatini, drinks while on safari, bottled water while in SZ, all needed material onsite for the service project, a full time guide.

WHAT IS NOT INCLUDED IN THIS PACKAGE? Airfare to and from Johannesburg, 10 dinners (budget \$15/dinner) 5 lunches, tips for housekeeping in Eswatini and for your ranger, tracker and staff on safari, travel insurance, trip cancellation insurance.

I WANT TO GO, HOW TO I RESERVE MY SPOT ON THIS TRIP? Send us \$1,000 CAD to hold your spot. This is 90% refundable up to February 1, 2024.

BALANCE IS DUE: 45 days before travel.







WILL I BE SAFE? Although one can never offer guarantees on such a trip, we can reassure you that we have been there 30 times without incident. Basic safety rules apply, we on the roads during the day, we stay only in best quality accommodations, eat at reputable restaurants, we use only the best quality and maintained vehicles and drivers for ground transportation, we have night watchmen at our accommodations, we lock up our belongings. This small country is not at war, it did however have some pro democracy political unrest in July 2021. There remains the occasional protest from the pro-democracy group. As the months pass, however, these events are dampening and infrequent. I am currently living here and can attest that life is completely normal. We guide families with children and student groups, all with equal comfort and safety.

HOW ABOUT HEALTH, WILL I GET SICK? Again, no guarantees, but we recently guided 29 people there with only two sore throats. We've taken approximately 100 people over the past years and 3 times we have had stomach flu or belly issue.

WHAT SAFETY MEASURES MUST I TAKE FOR HEALTH? No vaccines are required, however make your own decisions in this regard. Jacaranda's main health precaution is drinking only bottled water or bottled drinks. While on safari, you are in the low-veld, which has the potential for malaria. Make your own health decisions in this regard also.

WHO IS THIS TRIP MEANT FOR? People love travel, want to learn about Africa, who wish to give back, be active and experience a once in a lifetime safari!

WHAT ABOUT THE FOOD? ALLERIES? All meals will be good, wholesome and with well sourced ingredients. We can accommodate all eating types, aversions and allergies such as: vegan, vegetarian, gluten free, Celiac, nut and seafood allergies safely with healthy and delicious options.





CAN I DRINK THE WATER? You could, however we recommend drinking only bottled water, which is included in the cost and will be provided throughout the trip. You can bath/shower and brush your teeth in the tap water.

ARE THERE ANY MORE COMFORT PIECES TO THIS TRIP NOT YET REVEALED? We can visit the mineral hot springs in the area for a refreshing and cultural experience. It can be arranged to have a massage therapist or esthetician come to our accommodations for massage, pedi, or mani if desired. (added cost)

The fine print

Before attending this trip, you will be asked to provide the following:

- 1) Proof of travel health insurance
- 2) Signed release of liability forms provided by Jacaranda Journeys
- 3) Signed and completed health questionnaire
- 4) Copy of your travel arrival and departure details
- 5) Jacaranda Journeys is a travel company, Swazi Kids Society is the Canadian recognized charity for whom Jacaranda does project work, to adequately distinguish between these separate entities, you will be asked to sign a release form for Swazi Kids Society.

More fine print

BE FLEXIBLE: The descriptions and itineraries provided are guidelines of the trip before you. This is a developing country and many aspects of these details are subject to change or possibly be omitted. (Safari would be an exception as it is guaranteed.) We ask that participants remain open to adjustments in schedule, timing, extra-curricular activities, choices of restaurants etc.

SAFETY: it is expected that travelers remain on site at both the work site and the accommodation site. We request that anyone wanting to walk or run or otherwise leave the premises indicate this to your group leader before departing. There are some basic safety measures to be taken and such departures are by day light only.

HIV AND SEXUAL SAFETY: Eswatini has a very high HIV rate, it is expected that NO travelers will be engaging in sexual activity with any Eswatini citizens while on our guided trip. Your safety and health cannot be assured if you were to engage in such risky behavior. No one will be permitted to head off with friends that they may have met for any daytime event or an evening out, in a vehicle other than those provided by Jacaranda.
